



TEACH Grant Application

The Teacher Education Assistance for College and Higher Education (TEACH) Grant program provides grants of up to **\$3,772 per year (effective on or after 10/1/20)** to Graduate students who intend to teach in a public or private elementary or secondary school that serves students from low-income families.

To receive a TEACH grant you must:

- Have an undergraduate cumulative GPA of at least 3.25.
- Submit official transcripts from your undergraduate post-secondary institution, where you obtained your Bachelors Degree, to the Office of Financial Aid.

Or

- Have a current cumulative GPA of at least 3.25 for each subsequent term.

And

- Be enrolled in an eligible program, designed to prepare students to teach in a **high need field**.
 - Eligible programs are Special Education, Curriculum and Instruction with an ESL endorsement, Reading Education, and English as Second Language.
- Complete the FAFSA **each year**.
- Agree to serve as a full time teacher in a high need field for at least four academic years within eight years of completing the program for which you received the TEACH grant.
- Sign a *TEACH Grant Agreement to Serve* **each year** you receive the TEACH grant.
- Complete TEACH Grant Entrance Counseling **each year** you receive the TEACH grant.

IF YOU DO NOT COMPLETE THE REQUIRED TEACHING SERVICE, THE GRANT WILL BE CONVERTED TO AN UNSUBSIDIZED LOAN AND INTEREST WILL BE CHARGED FROM THE DATE OF EACH TEACH GRANT DISBURSEMENT.
