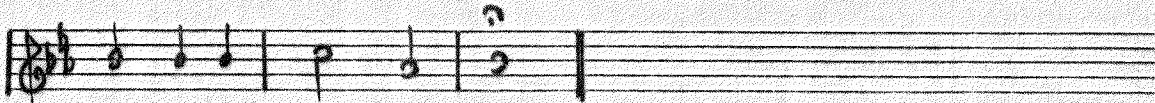

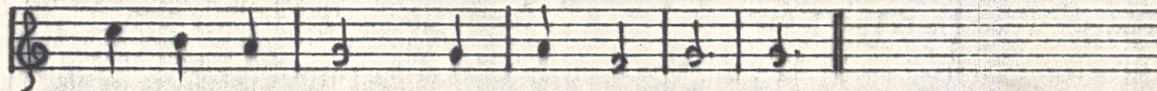

and give thanks to his holy name.

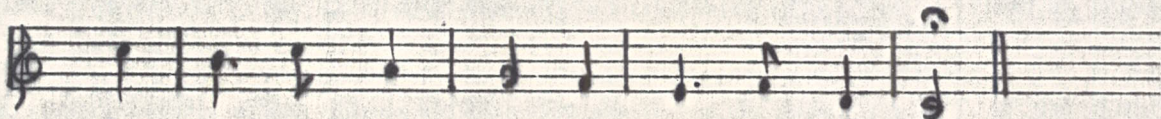

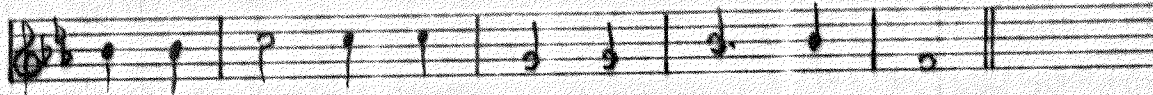

in the strength of a man;

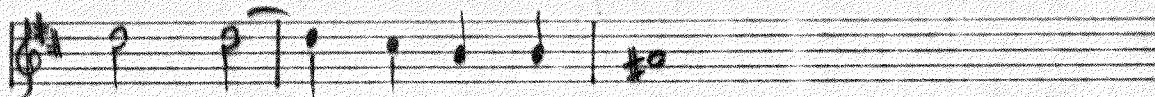
¹²but the LORD has pleasure
