



What is it?

Myhub is a secure and portable online application where students and alumni can access their verified education record. Through this service students can request an enrollment certificate for either their current term or all terms, order official copies of their transcripts, view the degrees they've earned, and other credentials.

Where is it?

- Students can access Myhub through Concordia Connect under the Academics tab.

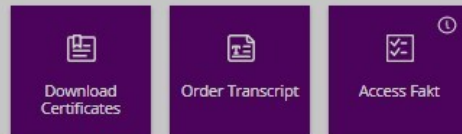

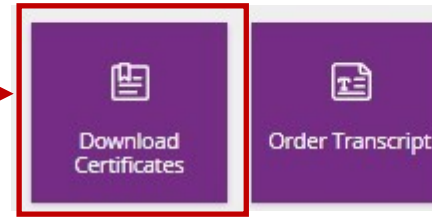
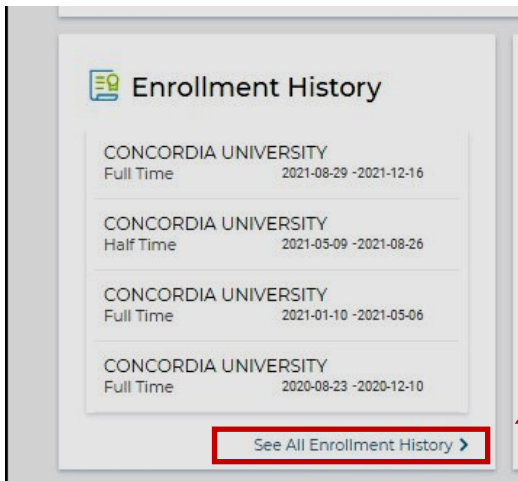
How to Request an Enrollment Verification/Certification

1) Click on one of the following

“Download Certificates” Action Button

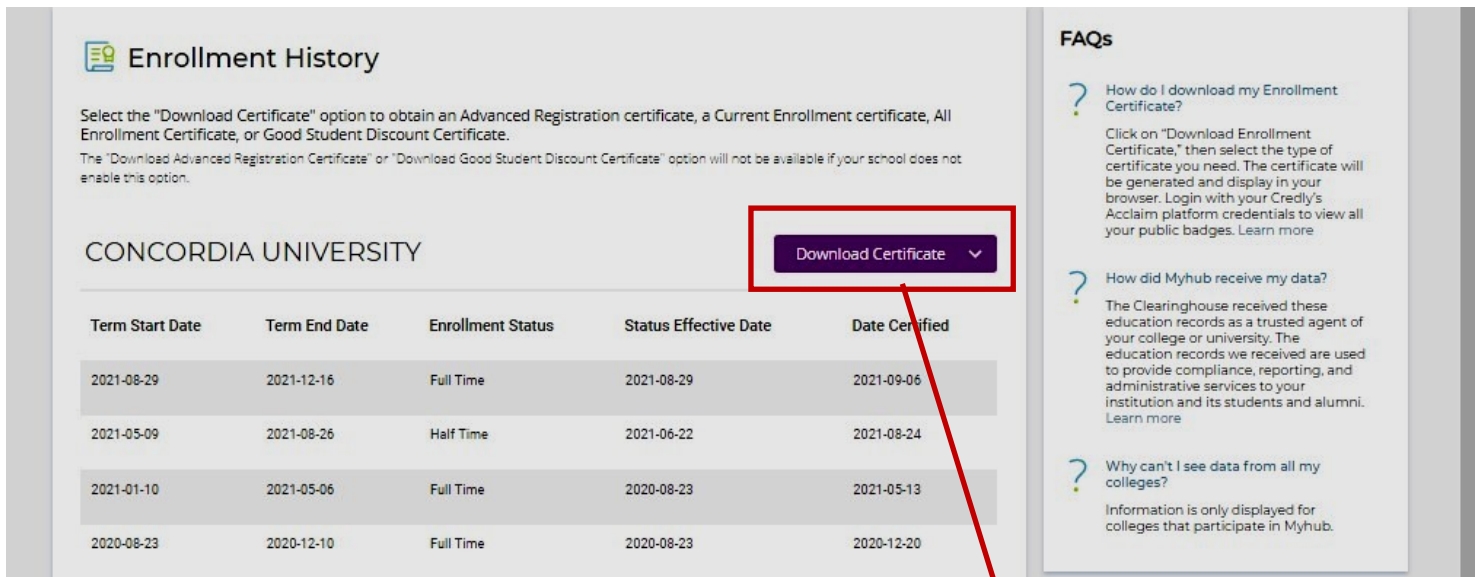
OR

2) You will be redirected to the below page which detailed your entire enrollment history.

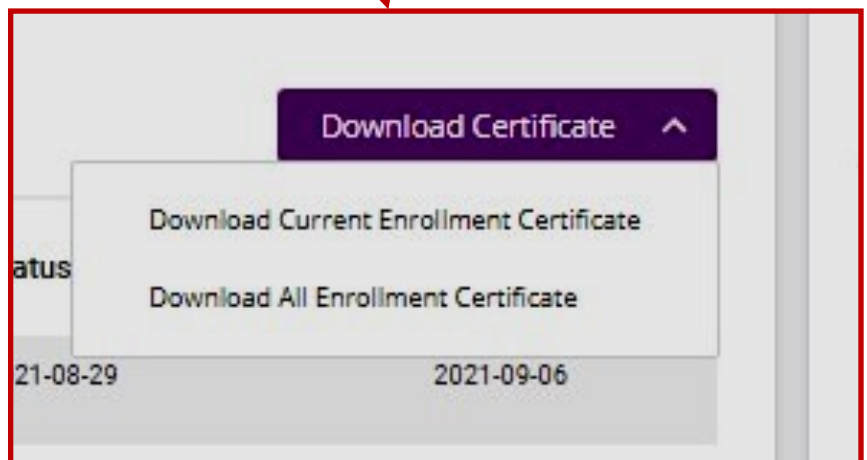
3) Click on the purple “Download Certificate button”



4) Chose one of the two offered options

⇒ “Current Enrollment Certificate” will show your current term enrollment

⇒ “All Enrollment Certificate” will show your entire enrollment at Concordia



5) Once you make your choice, your desired certificate will be downloaded to your computer for your desired use.

To send your enrollment verification to someone other than yourself, you will need to save it to your computer as a separate file.
