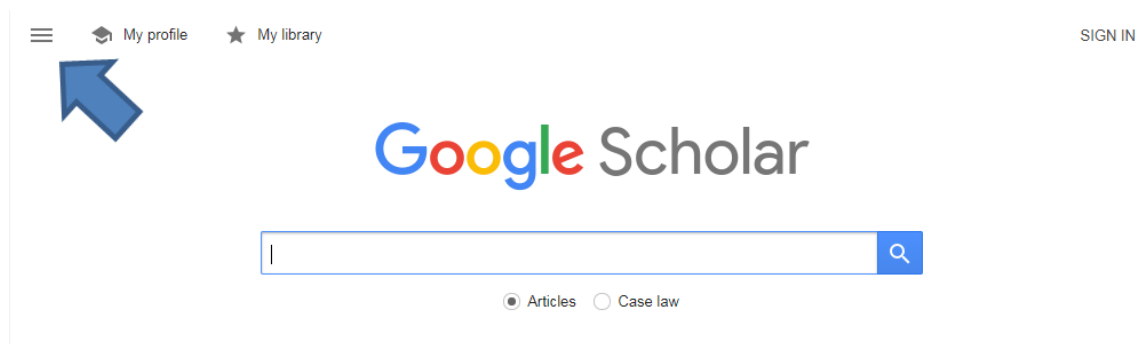


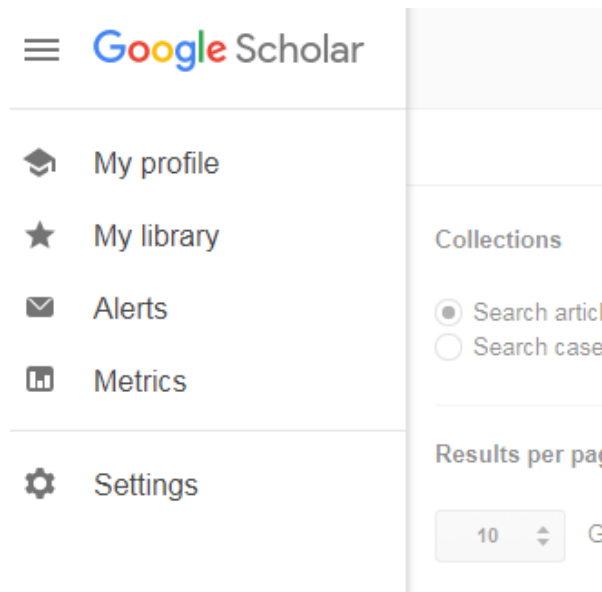
# Setting up Library Links in Google Scholar for Off-campus Users

*Increase your access to full-text information by linking the CUC EBSCOhost databases. On-campus users will automatically be connected to EBSCOhost holdings.*


- 1.) Begin by accessing Google Scholar: <https://scholar.google.com>.
- 2.) Click on the Menu Icon.



- 3.) Click on Settings.




4.) Click on Library links.

- 1.) After conducting a search in Google Scholar, you will find that the search results will have Full-Text links to the right of the results list. Note that not all search results will be available full-text.
