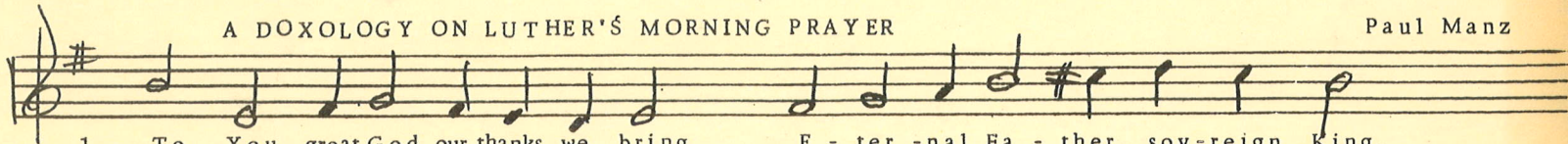


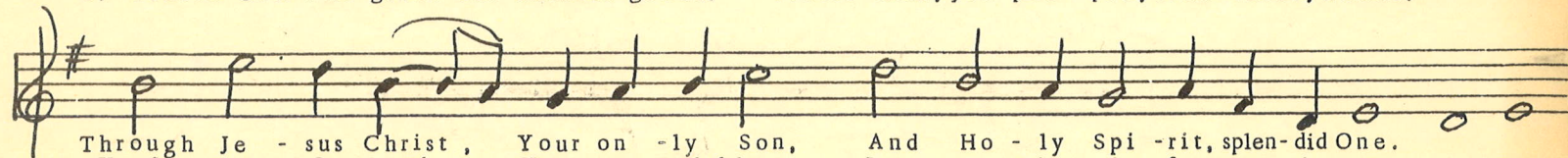
A DOXOLOGY ON LUTHER'S MORNING PRAYER
